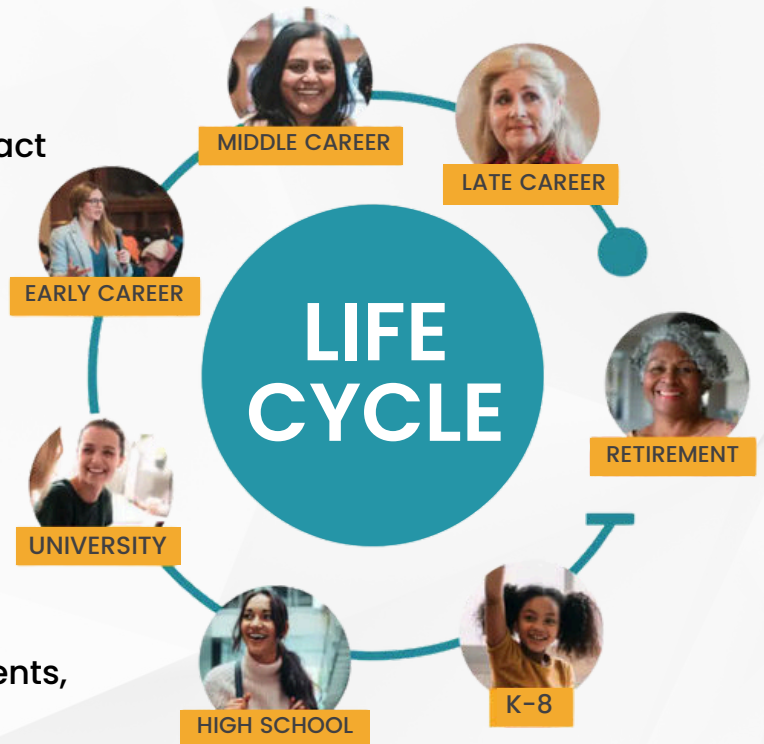

## ➞ Camp Infinity

Each week-long session provides hands-on tech activities for middle and high school girls across the state of Michigan, inspiring creativity and career opportunities.



## ➞ GET-IT Connection Summit

This engaging summit is designed for high school girls to explore technology, learn about career paths, and discover educational opportunities in the field.



## ➞ GET-IT Cyber Challenge

The biannual GET-IT Cyber Challenge enhances high school students' cybersecurity skills through a self-paced virtual program and culminates in an in-person finals competition.

## ➞ Girls GET-IT Clubs

Weekly after-school technology programs and hands-on activities across the state of Michigan foster a supportive community for girls interested in exploring computer science.



## ➞ Girls GET-IT Day

GET-IT Day empowered girls in grades 4-8 with hands-on tech learning, providing transportation and materials to explore career opportunities in the field.



## ➞ Girls Hack IT

Girls Hack IT provided high school girls hands-on coding experience and online mentorship, fostering real-world skills, confidence, and teamwork.



## ➞ Girls Rock IT

MCWT's partnership with the Girl Scouts offered a one-day event featuring hands-on activities for earning technology badges and patches, with MCWT volunteers leading the activities and speaking at the parents' program.

## ➔ Scholarships

Our scholarship program empowers Michigan women to pursue tech degrees and careers, with awards from \$2,000 to \$5,000, mentorship, and internship support.

## ➔ Internships

MCWT partners with Michigan companies to place college students in tech internships. Eligible students must have a 3.0 GPA, be enrolled in a tech program, and gain hands-on experience in the field.

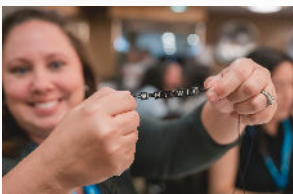

The Michigan Celebration of Women in Computing (MICWIC) – an ACM Celebration of Women in Computing – is a biennial event aimed at increasing women's meaningful participation in the computing profession. As part of a nationwide initiative by the ACM, MICWIC brings together university students to foster community, support, and inclusivity in computing, helping to counter feelings of isolation and build a strong network of women in tech.

This program benefits current and former managers, combining peer exchanges and insights from senior leaders to foster career growth and networking within cohorts.



## ➔ Leadership Clinic

This day-and-a-half clinic empowers experienced female managers through interactive sessions led by Michigan CIOs and tech leaders, focused on advancing leadership skills.



## ➔ Reignite!

This program supports women re-entering the workforce or transitioning to tech, offering a pathway for growth and development in a dynamic, in-demand industry.



## ➔ Women in Cyber

This hybrid program equips professional women with hands-on cybersecurity skills, using Immersive Labs' interactive content for collaborative learning and growth.



## ➔ Women TechPreneurs

This initiative supports women in tech entrepreneurship by providing essential skills, resources, and networks to help them succeed in Michigan's tech sector.



## ➔ Lunch & Learn

These 60-minute virtual sessions, featuring seasoned tech leaders, offer leadership and technical skills development. Recorded videos are available as a resource hub.
